
Reader's Service of Prayer for Protection from the Corona Virus

Litany of Fervent Supplication

Reader: Have mercy on us, O God, according to Thy great goodness, we pray Thee, hearken and have mercy.

Everyone: Lord, have mercy. (3 times)

Reader: Again we pray for our Metropolitan Tikhon, our Archbishop Michael, and all our brethren in Christ.

Everyone: Lord, have mercy. (3 times)

Reader: Again we pray for the President of our country, for all civil authorities, and for the armed forces.

Everyone: Lord, have mercy. (3 times)

Reader: Again we pray for mercy, life, peace, health, salvation, visitation, and the pardon and remission of sins for the servants of God (names of those we wish to pray for), who are under the impending threat of the Corona Virus, those who are suffering and those who are recovering from this affliction.

Everyone: Lord, have mercy. (3 times)

Reader: Again we pray that He will protect this home and this city and every city and countryside from the Corona Virus, pestilence, earthquake, flood, fire, the sword, the invasion of enemies, and from civil war; and that our good God will turn away from us all wrath stirred up against us, and deliver us from all His righteous chastisement which impends upon us, and have mercy on us.

Everyone: Lord, have mercy. (3 times)

People: Lord, have mercy. (3x)

READER: O Physician of souls and bodies, with compunction and contrite hearts we fall down before Thee, and with groaning we cry unto Thee: Heal the sicknesses and cure the passions of the soul and body of Thy servants those afflicted and affected by this virus and pardon us all our transgressions, both voluntary and involuntary, and quickly raise us up from our bed of sickness, we pray Thee, hearken and have mercy.

People: Lord, have mercy. (3x)

READER: O Thou Who desirest not the death of sinners, but rather that they should turn from their wickedness and return unto Thee and live: Spare and have mercy on Thy servants those afflicted and affected by this virus, O Merciful One; release all sickness, drive away all passion, heal all ailments, and stretch forth Thy mighty arm, and as Thou didst raise up Jairus' daughter from her bed of sickness, restore all of us to health and grant us length of days, we pray Thee, O Lord, hearken quickly and graciously show mercy.

People: Lord, have mercy. (3x)

READER: O Thou Who by Thy touch didst heal Peter's mother-in-law who was sick with a fever, do Thou now, in Thy great loving-kindness, heal Thy suffering servants those afflicted and affected by this virus, and gudie the minds and hands of our doctors, medical staff, nurses and all of those caring for our needs and bless the means they are using to work out a cure by and through Thy Divine Grace and Providence and quickly granting us health, length of days, recovery, and salvation, we diligently pray Thee, O Fountain of healings, hearken quickly and graciously show mercy.

People: Lord, have mercy. (3x)

READER: Again we pray to the Lord our God, that He may hearken unto the voice of the supplication of us sinners, and have mercy on His servants those afflicted and affected by this virus and protect us from all tribulation, harm, wrath and necessity, and from every sickness of soul and body, granting us health with length of days: we pray Thee, O Lord, hearken quickly and graciously show mercy.

Everyone: Lord, have mercy. (3 times)

Reader: Through the prayers of our Holy Fathers, Lord Jesus

Christ our God, have mercy on us.

Everyone: Amen.


Reader: Let us pray to the Lord.
